## **Achievements and performance**

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The year has been one of progress but not without setbacks, mostly relating to funding. However much has been achieved. Jamie Dale has retired as Trustee but is happy to support us when needed, we have two new volunteers, Taha Blici, social media and Claire McDonald, fundraising and they with Diana, have really strengthened the team.

ZTA and TAZ have worked together on developing more specialist uses of TA skills: training for HIV peer counsellors in conjunction with CIDRZ, CYP training for special needs teachers and others, delivering the Trauma protocol, delivering workplace well-being workshops for Challenges in- country teams. These are in addition to delivery of the ZTA course and the Y to W inputs. We were contacted by CTYA, Contact Trust Youth Association who are wanting to include Art Therapy in a new programme funded by Grand Challenges Canada. Lesley, Liz and Mwazanji were able to do introductory training for them during the visit and it is hoped this project will develop.

Despite the funding disappointments there have been 2 trips to Zambia in 2022 to contribute to this work. Lesley and Joanna early in the year, CYP training and Trauma protocol delivery, and Lesley and Liz in August to complete the CYP training. Funding was successfully sought from LUSH, Old Saint Pauls Church, Baillie Gifford and Destiny Church. MAITS has also contributed to 2 of the trips and we received a generous donation from an exTrustee, Colin Boxer.
